Mission Statement: Ovarian Awareness of KY provides educational resources, support to cancer patients and families, and research funding to raise awareness for ovarian and gynecologic cancers.

Service Accomplishments:

- On August 6, 2022, OAK, in collaboration with UL Health/Brown Cancer Center, held an Educational Symposium on GYN cancer at the UL Medical Campus. Presenters included Brown Cancer Center GYN oncologists, as well as a Palliative Care physician from Hospirus Health, and a hospice social worker.
- Survivors Teaching Students, a program run by cancer survivors, created by Ovarian Cancer Research Alliance, resumed in person presentations at UL Medical School.
- Monthly survivor support groups were held the 2nd Monday of each month at Gilda's Club Kentuckiana
- Toast to Life Brunch, a survivor celebration, was held at Owl Creek Country Club on August 26, 2022
- A survivor Holiday Dinner was held at Bravo's in Louisville on November 30, 2022
- Louisville Women's Expo, attended by over 1000 women during February 26-27, 2022
- KY Homemakers Convention held in Owensboro, KY May 10-11, 2022
- Big Four Bridge was lit in teal September 24-30, 2022, to commemorate Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month
- Hundreds of printed yard signs about the signs and symptoms of ovarian cancer, were distributed throughout KY
- Volunteers represented OAK at several health fairs throughout the year.
